

Doors open at 5:30 pm, dinner from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm and The Oracle Band performs from 7:00 pm to 11:00 pm. Tickets are \$55, inclusive of dinner and drinks (open pit sliced beef, smoked pulled pork, potato salad, coleslaw, baked beans, pasta salad, rolls, desserts, draft beer, wines, sodas, water). Proceeds for this fundraising event has been designated to assist the USO at Baltimore Washington International Airport by way of in-kind donation as well as the Patriot House.

The "Patriot House: A Home for Veterans" is the first and only in Anne Arundel County. It is designed to assist Veterans who are homeless with the transition back to independent living. This program has received support from the local, state a federal level, and is much needed in Anne Arundel County. The program houses up to six Veterans, along with one live-in staff member, and is handicap accessible. The program has a strong employment, training, and educational component as well as support services for all other health-related matters. Potential residents are required to pass a background check and drug screening prior to admittance. The program is recovery based and all residents are required to submit to mandatory drug and alcohol testing. Residents may live in the program for up to two years, with the goal of moving them back to independent living.
