From the Chaplain

The other night I saw a message from someone I served with in Afghanistan. He had seriously considered suicide just a few nights ago. While he was in the depths of exploring this permanent solution to his temporary problems he thought of his family and friends. It was the thought of what suicide would do to them that brought him up from the depths. Thank God he was able to find a reason to live in the midst of his struggle. Thank God he was alive the next day to seek help.

Not everyone is so lucky. While we are in the midst of celebrating Independence Day, back yard barbecues, and summer vacations remember that many people are hurting on the inside. Remember the acronym "ACE." Be bold and **ASK** the tough question, "Are you thinking about suicide?" If they are thinking about suicide, **CARE** for them by listening without judgment. The final step is to **ESCORT** them to safety.

Even in the midst of our summer celebrations remember to keep an eye out for our fellow veterans.
