Back to School Backpacks

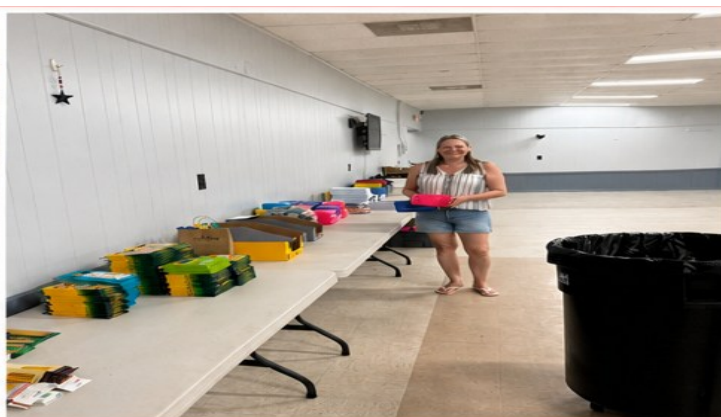
